## Application under national laws

Goods temporarily admitted (in the context of the ATA Convention):

1. Professional equipment
2. Goods for display or use at an exhibition, fair or similar event
3. Pedagogic material and scientific equipment or goods for Cultural purposes
4. Medical, surgical and laboratory equipment
5. Goods imported for humanitarian purposes
6. Packings
7. Goods of any kind which are to be subjected to tests, analyses or experiments, but excluding any tests, experiments or demonstrations constituting a gainful activity
8. Samples and specimens
9. Replacement means of production assets
10. Works of art imported for the purposes of exhibition, with a view to possible sale
11. Positives of cinematograph films, printed and developed, or other record-containing media designed for image recording, intended for viewing prior to commercial use.
12. Films, magnetic tapes and magnetized films which are intended to be provided with a soundtrack, dubbed or copied.
13. Films demonstrating the nature of the operation of foreign products or equipment, provided that they are not intended for public showing for charge.
14. Data-carrying media, sent free of charge for use in automatic data processing.
15. Articles (including vehicles) which, by their nature, are unsuitable for any purposes other than advertising of specific purpose.
16. Live animals of any species imported for dressage, training or breeding purposes or in order to be given veterinary treatment.
17. Tourist publicity material
18. Various equipment used, under the supervision and responsibility of a public authority, for the building, repair or maintenance of infrastructure of general importance in frontier zones.

19. Welfare materials for seafarers.

## Replacement carnet

1. Yes, in accordance with Article 251 Union Customs Code (UCC).
2. When the original carnet expires and a replacement carnet needs to be processed, if the goods are located in the Czech Republic, this procedure can take place in the Czech Republic even if the initial importation was made in another EU member state.
3. Additional observations (if any):  
In the abovementioned case, the presentation of the original Carnet ATA is strictly required and must be still valid at the time of submission.
