Languages in which Carnets should be completed

German

The Customs may require a translation if the Carnet is completed in any other language unless the particulars given can be understood. In practice, no difficulty arises in respect of the languages normally used in EU for international trade.

Replacement carnet

1. Yes, in accordance with Article 251 Union Customs Code (UCC).
2. When the original carnet expires and a replacement carnet needs to be processed, if the goods are located in Germany, this procedure can take place in Germany even if the initial importation was made in another EU member state.
