Languages in which Carnets should be completed

Greek, English.

The Customs will not require a translation when the Carnet has been completed in another language if the examining officers understand that language.

Replacement carnet

1. Yes, in accordance with Article 251 Union Customs Code (UCC).
2. When the original carnet expires and a replacement carnet needs to be processed, if the goods are located in Greece, this procedure can take place in Greece even if the initial importation was made in another EU member state.

Regularization fee requested by Customs

Customs offices

All Customs offices at regional headquarters and all Class 1 offices.

Frontiers offices: 24 hours a day for transit operations. Officers of importation: official hours of opening.

Special observations

When temporarily importing and re-exporting via road, transit operations will be undertaken between the border office and the internal office.
