Languages in which Carnets should be completed

Swedish, English, German, Danish, French, Norwegian. The Customs may require a translation if the carnet is completed in any other language.

Replacement carnet

1. Yes, in accordance with Article 251 Union Customs Code (UCC).
2. When the original carnet expires and a replacement carnet needs to be processed for non-EU goods, the replacement procedure shall be carried out in the country where the initial importation into the EU was made.
