#### Regularization fee requested by Customs

(a) Failing to re-export or re-import goods by the final date as stipulated by Customs;

(b) Non-presentation of the Carnet forms to Customs for endorsement/ verification upon exportation from/importation into and re-importation into/re-exportation from the UAE.

(c) Failing to notify Customs in writing when goods covered by a Carnet are not re-exported/re-imported due to whatever reason.

(d) False declaration of value of the goods which may include seizure, confiscation of the goods, prosecution, etc.

Penalties which may amount to a maximum of three times the value of the goods where applicable will also be payable.

In the event of any Customs offence being committed, the provisions of the Common Customs Law and Rules of Implementation thereof shall be applicable.

#### **Special observations**

All Carnets which arrive to UAE beyond the Customs official working hours as stated in the table will be subjected to service charge of AED 100.

Only Abu-Dhabi and Dubai accept / receive incoming carnets.

Period of temporary admission shall not exceed six months (180 days) renewable for similar periods, but not to exceed one year.

(A fine of AED 1000 for each week of delay or a fraction of the week provided that the fine shall not exceed 20% of the value of goods)
